

## RULES 2019 EDITION

### COMMUNITY SHARES– BE THE HERO IN YOUR COMMUNITY DRAW

#### IN COLLABORATION WITH RBC

To benefit West Island Community Shares

1. On June 17, 2019 the charitable organization, West Island Community Shares (hereinafter Community Shares) will draw five (5) prizes:

**1<sup>st</sup> prize:** 10 RBC lodge tickets for the Michael Bubl  show on Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019, at the Bell Center level 3.42 (excluding food and drinks). Value of \$ 3,500;

**2<sup>nd</sup> prize:** Three (3) gift certificates to Italian restaurants, La Verit  \$100, Vivaldi \$ 50 and Scarolie’s \$ 40. Value of \$ 190 ;

2. The draws will be held at 8:30 p.m. on Monday June 17, 2019 at the 40 Westt Restaurant & Bar located at 2,305 Transcanadienne, Pointe-Claire, Qu bec, H9R 5Z5.
3. The total value of the prizes is \$ 4,115.
4. The tickets cost \$ 20 each and may be purchased in one payment in cash, by cheque (in the name of West Island Community Shares), or by VISA, Mastercard or AMEX. Credit card transactions will be processed by West Island Community Shares.
5. The number of tickets printed is 1,200 and they are numbered from 0001 to 1,200. The number of the *R gie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Qu bec* permit appearing on the tickets is 428876-1.
6. There is no limit to the number of tickets a person may purchase.
7. The tickets will be on sale until June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 8:29 p.m.
8. The prizes will be drawn in reverse order from that listed above.

9. The winners will be contacted and informed about how they may claim their prize. The winners must sign a declaration releasing the organizers of any liability. The prizes must be claimed by 4:00 p.m. on September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the offices of Community Shares, located at 610, boulevard S-Jean, suite 200, Pointe-Claire, Québec, H9R 3K2, 514-695-8694 extension 103.
